

note and in said Mortgage or the interest-accruing thereon has been paid to the Complainant except the credits herein after stated although the time limited for payment thereof by the condition aforesaid has long since passed and payment thereof duly demanded and that the whole of said sum of money and interest thereon remains due and owing, except the interest paid thereon up to the 23rd day of January 1866 and the sum of six hundred ^{years} dollars paid January 22nd 1866 and the sum of \$190 paid on the 21st day of December 1867 and the sum of Four hundred and Seventy three dollars paid April 1st 1868 as appears by the credit of said Note. Your Complainant further charges that the said Benjamin Willhite did interlate sometime in the month of — in the year 1871 leaving a widow named Mary ^W Willhite his surviving and the following to wit: 1st George W Willhite a Son, 2 Arnold R Willhite a son, 3 Frederick A Willhite 4 Amelia Herbert now the wife of Franklin Herbert; 5 Ann Anders now the wife of Samuel Anders that said George W Willhite is now resident of the State of Maryland and do not reside therein and their residences at the time is unknown to your Complainant that Franklin Herbert and Amelia Herbert his wife resided in Hagerstown Washington County Maryland, Arnold R Willhite, Frederick A Willhite and Mary Barbara Willhite Widow and Samuel Anders and Ann Anders his wife reside in Frederick County State of Maryland and that said Lands subject to the payment of this Mortgage descended to his said children as his heirs at law and that said Jacob M Shunkle is dead

To the end therefore that the said Defendants hereafter named may answer the several matters and things hereinbefore stated as fully and as particularly as if they were herein again repeated and they were thereunto severally interrogated and that the said Mortgaged premises or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose he sold for payment of the claim of your Complainant with interest on the same and that your Complainant may have such other and further relief as the nature and equity of his cause requires May it please your Honors to grant unto your Complainant an order of Publication giving notice to the said George W Willhite who is now resident as before stated of the substance and object of this Bill and warning him to appear in this Court in person or by Solicitor on or before a certain day to answer the premises and show cause if any he has why a decree ought not to pass as prayed and also the writ of Subpoena against the said Franklin Herbert and Amelia Herbert his wife of Washington County State of Maryland and Arnold R Willhite Frederick A Willhite Mary Barbara Willhite and Samuel Anders and Ann Anders his wife of Frederick County commanding them to appear in this Court in person or by Solicitor at some certain day to be therein named to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein, And as in duty so
