The above cause standing ready for a hearing and being submitted the Bill, Answer, Exhibit & evidence and all other proceedings were by the Court read and considered.

It is therefore this 12 day of February in the year 1873 by the Judge of the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity and by the authority of said Court adjudged ordered and decreed that unless the Defendant shall on or before the 31st day of February next pay or bring into Court here to be paid into the Complainant the sum of three hundred dollars with interest thereon from the 15th day of April A. D. 1865 until paid or brought in as aforesaid together with the Complainant's costs of this suit to be taxed by the Clerk the mortgaged premises in the proceedings mentioned or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose he sold and that James McHenry of Frederick County be and he hereby appointed Trustee to make the said sale and that the course and manner of his proceeding shall be as follows: He shall first file in the Clerk's Office of this Court a Bond to the State of Maryland executed by him with a surety or sureties to be approved by the Court or the Clerk thereof in the penalty of One Thousand dollars conditioned for the faithful performance of the trust reposed in him by this decree or which may hereafter
