

the heir of Benj. H. Gattou deceased by his fraudulent enticement and to delay defraud and hinder your Orator and his other Creditors procure the aforesaid deed to be made to Susannah E. Gattou his wife for the nominal consideration of Fifteen hundred dollars.

And your Orator further charges that the aforesaid Susannah E. Gattou was not possessed of Fifteen hundred dollars at the time the aforesaid conveyance was made and executed to her by the heir aforesaid, and that she had no means of raising the said Fifteen hundred dollars recited as the consideration in said conveyance. Your Orator avers that the said James H. Gattou was indebted at the time of the conveyance aforesaid from the heir aforesaid to Susannah E. Gattou aforesaid unto your Orator in the full and just sum of two hundred and forty one dollar and forty cents as will more fully appear by the accompanying Exhibit annexed to this Bill and filed as part of it marked Exhibit E. and was at the time of the making of such conveyance largely indebted to other creditors the exact nature and extent of which your Orator is not advised. To the end therefore that the said James H. Gattou and Susannah E. Gattou may answer the matter and things herein before stated and that the aforesaid deed from Mrs. H. Gattou H. A. Gattou P. B. Stouffer and Amanda C. Stouffer his wife to Susannah E. Gattou the wife of James H. Gattou may be annulled and set aside and that the Real Estate described in said deed to Susannah E. Gattou may be sold for payment of the claims of your Orator and other unatisfied Creditors and that your Orator may have such further or other relief in the premises as Equity may require, May it please your honors to grant unto your Orator the Writ of Subpoena against the said James H. Gattou and Susannah E. Gattou his wife of Frederick's County commanding them to appear in this Court at some certain day to be therein named to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein and your Complainants will ever praye.

At the request of Amanda C. Stouffer the following deed was recorded Sept. 22nd 1866 Stamp \$1.
 New Deed made this 20th day of September in the year 1866 by James H. Gattou and Susannah E. Gattou his wife William H. Gattou and Harriet A. Gattou heirs at Law of B. H. Gattou deceased all of Frederick County and State of Maryland, Witnesses that in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars (\$600.) the said James H. Gattou and Susannah E. Gattou his wife, William H. Gattou and Harriet A. Gattou do grant in fee simple unto Amanda C. Stouffer an heir at Law of said deceased and wife of Peter B. Stouffer all their right title and interest both at Law and in Equity in and to all the Lots and parcels of ground with all the buildings thereon situate in the village of the Point of Rocks in said County and State and fully described in the following deed to wit: in a deed from P. B. Stouffer and others to said B. H. Gattou bearing date the 19th day of October A. D. 1839 and recorded in Liber B. G. H. No. 5 folios 317 & 318 out of the Land Records of said County and in a
