Answer of Sus. E. Gallow

To the Hon. M. Nelson Judge of the Circuit Court for Frederick County in Equity. The answer of Susannah E. Gallow of Frederick County to the Bill of Complaint of Ephraim Albaugh in this Court exhibited.

This Defendant admits that about the year 1863 a certain Benjamin Gallow did interstate and seized of certain Real Estate described in said Bill of Complaint and Exhibits and that said Real Estate descended to James H. Gallow Mrs. J. Gallow H. A. Gallow and Amanda Stauffer wife of P. B. Stauffer as tenants in common, and the Defendant admits that by an arrangement between said tenants in common deeds "inter partes" were passed by way of partition amongst them as appears by Exhibits 1, 2, 3 & 4 filed with Complainant's Bill.

And for further answer she utterly denies that the deed to defendant referred to was procured to be made to her by James H. Gallow by fraudulent contrivances and to delay hinder and defraud the Complainant and the other Creditors of James H. Gallow or was made to Defendant for a valuable consideration and was bona-fide &c. without any fraud or covin upon the part of her the said Defendant.

And for further answer she denies that at the date of the aforesaid conveyance she was not possessed of Fifteen hundred dollars and that she had no means of raising the said Fifteen hundred dollars the consideration of the deed aforesaid.

And she for further answer denies that James H. Gallow was indebted at the time of said conveyance to Ephraim Albaugh the Complainant in the full and just sum of two hundred and forty one dollars and forty cents as charged in the said Bill of Complaint but admits that said James H. Gallow was at such time largely indebted to other Creditors &c. &c. Wherefore she prays she may be hence dismissed with her Costs and that the Complainant's Bill of Complaint may be dismissed with costs &c. &c.
