

your Orator or to render unto him any account of the aforesaid personal estate in his hands and your Orator is unable to obtain adequate relief against him or against the aforesaid Real Estate without the aid of this Court. To the therefore that the defendants hereinafter named may answer the several matters and things hereinafore set forth as fully and particularly as if the same were herein again repeated and they were thereunto specially interrogated, and that the said David Hess may also set forth an account of the Personal Estate of the said Peter Redinger and the amount and proceeds thereof possessed by him and what part thereof is now in his hands and how much thereof has been disposed of by him in payment of the debts of the said Peter Redinger or otherwise and what debts and to what amount remain unsatisfied and that an account may be taken under the direction of this Court of the said debts so as aforesaid due to your Orator and all other debts which were owing by the said Peter Redinger at the time of his death and which still remain unpaid and also of the personal estate and effects of the said Peter Redinger received by or for the use of the said Peter Redinger as Administrator aforesaid, and that the said personal estate may be applied in due course of Administration in payment of the debts of the said Peter Redinger due to your Orator and all other Creditors who may come in and contribute to the expenses of this suit and that the aforesaid Real Estate or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose may be decreed to be sold for the payment of so much of the aforesaid debts as may remain unsatisfied by the application of the personal estate as aforesaid and that your Orator may have such further or other relief as his case may require. May it please your Honorable Court to grant unto your Orator the writ of subpoena against David Hess Administrator with the Will annexed of Peter Redinger deceased, Mary Jane Redinger Barbara Redinger, Abraham Redinger, John Redinger, Clara Redinger Sarah C. Redinger Anna Redinger and Samuel Redinger all of Carroll County Maryland commanding them to appear in this Court at some certain day to be therein named to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein and as in duty bound your Orator will ever pray.
