

Order of Court

Upon reading the aforesaid Petition it is this 22nd day of November in the year 1872 by the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity and by the authority thereof ordered adjudged and decreed that the said Charles Hendry who has been reported to this Court as the purchaser of the Real Estate in these proceedings mentioned be and he is hereby released from said purchase and Peter Arnold is hereby substituted as the purchaser of the said Real Estate at and for the sum of twenty seven hundred dollars instead of the said Charles Hendry and the said Charles Hendry is hereby authorized to execute to the said Peter Arnold a deed for the said Real Estate as Mortgage upon the payment of the whole of the purchase money aforesaid and the said sale is hereby finally ratified and confirmed.

Agreement of Counsel

Charles Hendry Mortgage } No. 3835 Equity.
of Alexander Jamison & Wife } In the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting in Equity.
It is hereby agreed between the undersigned Solicitors for the respective parties to this suit or proceeding that in consideration of the payment to the Mortgage Charles Hendry of the sum of \$2700⁰⁰ to be applied to the purpose of this suit or proceeding by Peter Arnold, the said Peter Arnold shall be substituted as purchaser of the property in these proceedings mentioned in the place and stead of the said Hendry and that the same be reported to the Circuit Court for Frederick County, in Equity, for immediate ratification, and that the papers in the cause be then referred to the Auditor to state an account between the Mortgage and the parties interested in the proceeds of sale of the said property that in said account of the Auditor the said Hendry Mortgage shall be allowed the sum of \$2486⁰⁰ being the principal and interest due the said Hendry to the 23rd day of November 1872 under the said Mortgage and by this agreement ascertained and fixed as the true amount due him, and that the said Hendry shall be further allowed all expenses and costs usual and proper to be allowed in such cases according to the practice of the Circuit Court for Frederick County including commissions for selling as stipulated in the said Mortgage (all questions as to such costs and expenses to be open to the parties before the Court) and it is hereby further agreed that the application for injunction in case No. 3830 now pending in the Circuit Court for Frederick County and growing out of the proceedings in the above entitled cause shall be submitted for a hearing by the said Court as if this agreement had not been made and this agreement shall in no wise interfere therewith and when said application for injunction has been heard and determined by the said Court the party against whom such decision shall be made shall be liable for costs but the Corn Crop affected by said injunctions shall thereafter be the property of Lloyd J Jamison and the said Hendry shall relinquish all claim thereto as settlement of all questions, suits, actions, costs and trouble connected with or in any manner growing out of the said injunction suit.
