10<sup>th</sup> Sub. He did have children surviving him, I know their names, namely. George S Staley, S Milton Staley, Leter, Annie, Estella, Catharine Blanche and Olivia all of whom are still living.

11<sup>th</sup> Sub. It is not susceptible of division and could not be divided at all, as it consists of a house and Lot and a Blacksmith-Shop.

12<sup>th</sup> Sub. It would be for the benefit and advantage of all parties concerned that said Real Estate should be sold and the proceeds thereof distributed among the parties entitled for the reasons stated in the answer to the foregoing Interrogatory and because said property is daily depreciating in value.
