

and the name of whose wife is Caroline Riddlemoser both of whom are Adults and reside in Baltimore City a son George W Riddlemoser who is married and the name of whose wife is Mary T Riddlemoser both of whom are Adults and non residents of the State of Maryland residing in the State of Pennsylvania, a grand son Charles Edgar Riddlemoser who is the son of Jacob A Riddlemoser who was a son of said Joseph Riddlemoser but died before his said father, said Charles Edgar Riddlemoser being unmarried and an infant under the age of twenty one years and a non-resident of the State of Maryland residing in the State of Pennsylvania a daughter Eliza now the wife of Francis M Buddy both of whom are Adults and reside in Baltimore City and a daughter Mary A now wife of Lewis Elliott both of whom are adults and reside in Carroll County in the State of Maryland, and a daughter Julia A now wife of Aloysius F Orendoff both of whom are Adults and are the Complainants in this Bill Your Complainants further state that said Joseph Riddlemoser died seized and possessed of certain Real Estate situated in Frederick County described in a deed from Henry Riddlemoser and wife and others to Henry Riddlemoser Sr a certified copy of which is herewith filed marked Exhibit No. 1 which with all other Exhibits herewith filed or to be filed your Complainants pray may be taken as part of their Bill of Complaint. Your Complainants further charge that said Real Estate is not susceptible of division without loss and injury to the parties interested and that it will be to the benefit and advantage of all the parties interested infant as well as Adult that the same be sold under the decree of your Honorable Court and the proceeds thereof distributed among the parties interested in proportion to their respective rights. Your Complainants further state that said Real Estate was conveyed by said Henry Riddlemoser and Harriet his wife, said Joseph Riddlemoser and Caroline his wife said George W Riddlemoser and Mary T his wife said Aloysius F Orendoff and Julia A his wife the Complainants in this bill said Francis M Buddy, said Lewis Elliott and Mary A his wife and a certain Lydia A Riddlemoser who is the mother of said infant Charles Edgar Riddlemoser and who is now the wife of Hezekiah Latchum both of whom husband and wife are Adults and non-residents of the State of Maryland residing in Adams County in the State of Pennsylvania, and your Complainants further state that said Real Estate was conveyed to said Joseph Riddlemoser by the name of Henry Riddlemoser Senior being a mistake and error made by the Surveyor who prepared the deed, that there is and was no Henry Riddlemoser Senior and that the intention of the Grantors in said deed was to convey the same to said Joseph Riddlemoser senior To this end that said Defendants hereinafter named may answer the premises and that said conveyance may be rectified and that said Real Estate may be sold for the purposes of partition, and that your Complainants may have such further and other relief in the premises as the nature and Equity of their case may require. May it please your Honors to grant unto your Complainants the writ of Subpoena against the said Joseph Riddlemoser and Caroline Riddlemoser his wife and Francis M Buddy and Eliza Buddy his wife of Baltimore City and Lewis Elliott and Mary A Elliott his wife of Carroll County and Mary Riddlemoser of Frederick commanding them and each of them to appear in this Court on some certain day to be therein named to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein. And may it also please your Honors to grant unto your Complainants an order of publication giving notice to the said Henry Riddlemoser and Harriet Riddlemoser his wife George W
