Crudorf and Julia A his wife Francis Cuddy and Elysa his wife Alfred Riddlemose and Lydia A his wife and Lewis Elliott and Mary A his wife heirs at Law of Ephraim Riddlemose deceased, It is with that in consideration of Five hundred and twenty five dollars the parties aforesaid doth grant unto Henry Riddlemose senior all that Lot of ground and buildings situate in Shields Addition to Emmitsburg in Frederick County State of Maryland and designated on the plat of said town by number 14 and by deed of conveyance by Samuel Kelly to Ephraim Riddlemose bearing date the 24th day of May 1858 and recorded in Liber C. & D. No. 3 folio one of the Land Records of Frederick County in fee simple
