4. State all you know in regard to the ownership of said property and in
regard to the title thereto.

5. Did or did not the said Joseph Riddlemour have a widow surviving him. If
you, is she dead or alive, state her name ^{age} and present place of residence.

6. Did or did not the said Joseph Riddlemour leave children surviving him,
If you state their names, ages, conditions and present place of residence, and if
any are dead, give the time and place of death and the names ages and present
places of residence of their representatives.

7. State whether or not said Real Estate is susceptible of division without loss or
injury to the parties interested, state any facts or circumstances which lead you
to the opinion you entertain on this subject.

8. State whether or not it will be to the benefit and advantage of all the parties
interested infant as well as adult that said Real Estate be sold and the
proceeds divided among the parties in proportion to their respective rights
state the reasons for the opinion you entertain on this subject.

9. State whether or not you have any interest in the said property or the
proceeds of sale arising therefrom
