The Comptenants filed with the Commissioner as evidence "Exhibits No. 1 & 2" which are herewith returned by the said Commissioner, and there being no witnesses present to be examined and further time being required for the production of evidence the said Commission was adjourned to the 25th day of May A. D. 1875, at which time and at the place aforesaid and in the absence of John E. R. Wood Commissioner then and there proceeded to take the following depositions.

James A. Cudorff, a witness of lawful age produced upon the part of the Comptenants being duly sworn and examined, to interrogatories filed with the Commissioner by the Comptenants & herewith returned deposes and says to the.

1st Int. I know all the parties except Hezekiah Lathaw and know there is such a person who married the widow of Jacob Alfred Kiddlemoss for some years

2nd Int. I was, He is dead. He died in Emmittsburg Frederick County Md, in the summer of 1861.

3rd Int. He was. It was a weather-boarded house situated in Emmittsburg Frederick County Md. I look at "Exhibit No 1" now here shown me it properly describes said property. Its worth about Eight or Nine hundred dollars

4th Int. Joseph Kiddlemoss lived and died there and was considered the owner of said property by everybody and was really the owner. There was no such man as Henry Kiddlemoss Senr. There was only one Henry Kiddlemoss and he was the son of Joseph Kiddlemoss and he is a party to the deed of which "Exhibit No. 1" is a copy. I am thoroughly satisfied that it was Joseph Kiddlemoss property, and no deed and if conveyed to a man named Henry Kiddlemoss Senr it was a mistake because there was no such man.

5th Int. He did. She is still living. Her name is Mary Kiddlemoss. She resided in Frederick County Md until last winter, since which time she has lived in Taneytown Carroll County Md. She is unmarried and about Seventy five or Seventy six years of age.

6th Int. He did, as follows: a son Henry who is married and whose wife's name is Harriet both adults and residing out of the State of Maryland. Joseph married and whose wife's name is I think is Caroline both adults & residing in Baltimore City Maryland. George H. married and whose wife's name is Mary D. both adults and residing in the State of Pennsylvania. Jacob A. who died before his father Joseph Kiddlemoss Senr and left surviving him a son named Charles Edgar Kiddlemoss who is unmarried and an infant & residing in the State of Pennsylvania and a widow named Lydia A. Kiddlemoss who is now the wife of Hezekiah Lathaw both adults and residing in the State of Pennsylvania, a daughter Eliza married to Francis M. Biddy both adults and residing in the City of Baltimore Md. a daughter Mary A. wife of Lewis Elliot and residing in Carroll County Md. and a daughter Julia wife of
