7th dnt. It is not susceptible of division among the parties concerned without loss and injury. The property consists of a small house & lot and is incapable of being divided.

8th dnt. It ^{is} for the benefit and advantage of all parties concerned that said Real Estate should be sold and the proceeds thereof distributed among the parties entitled for the same reasons as given in my answer to the last preceding Interrogatory and because the property is now rented and nobody to take care of it and the sooner it is sold the better it will be for all parties.

9th dnt. I have none.

Daniel G. Adelsperger a witness of lawful age produced upon the part of the Complainants being duly sworn and examined to Interrogatories filed with the Commissioner by the Complainants and herewith returned deposed and says to the,

1st dnt. I have known all the parties for some years except Hezekiah Latham whom I do not know, but I know there is such a person whom married the widow of Jacob Alfred Riddlemose deceased

2nd dnt. I was, He died in Frederick County Maryland in the summer of 1861.

3rd dnt. He was. It was a weather-boarded house situated in Emmittsburg Frederick County Md. I look at Exhibit No 1 now here shown me, said Exhibit properly describes said property. The property is worth about Eight or Nine hundred dollars.

4th dnt. Joseph Riddlemose lived and died there and was considered the owner of said property by everybody and he was really the owner. There was no such man as Henry Riddlemose Senr. There was only one Henry Riddlemose and he was the son of Joseph Riddlemose and is a party to the deed of which Exhibit No. 1 is a copy. I am perfectly satisfied that it was Joseph Riddlemose property and no one else's and if it was deeded to a man named Henry Riddlemose Senr it was a mistake because there was no such man in existence.

5th dnt. He did. Her name is Mary. She resided in this County until last winter when she removed to Taneytown Carroll County Md. where she now resides she is unmarried and is about seventy five or six years of age.

6th dnt. He did, as follows: a son Henry whose wife's name is Harriett both adults and residing out of the State of Maryland, a son Joseph whose wife's name is Caroline I think, both adults and residing in Baltimore City Md. a son Geo. W. whose wife's name is Mary D. both Adults & residing in Pennsylvania. a son Jacob A. died before Joseph Riddlemose Senr his father and who left surviving him a son named Charles Edgar Riddlemose who is unmarried and an infant and resides in Pennsylvania and a widow named Lydia A. who is now the wife of Hezekiah Latham both adults and residing in Pennsylvania a daughter Eliza married to Francis W. Puddy both Adults and
