



This Indenture made this 9th day of May in the year 1845 by and between George
Paer of Frederick County and State of Maryland of the first part and Henry Shafer of
the County and State aforesaid of the second part Whereas by a decree of Frederick
County Court sitting as a Court of Equity bearing date the 24th day of January 1839 the said
George Paer was appointed Trustee to make sale of the property in said decree mention-
ed and herein named and conveyed and whereas the said George Paer in
pursuance of said decree did sell and dispose of to the said Henry Shafer the property
hereinafter described and convey for the sum of Three hundred and Fifty six dollars
and Fifty cents current money in hand paid by the said Henry Shafer, and whereas the
sale for the said property hath been duly reported by the said Trustee to the Court
aforesaid and the sale thereof fully ratified and confirmed by the Court thereof, and
whereas the purchase money for said property and premises having been fully paid
and satisfied the said George Paer doth agree to execute these presents in pursuance
