The Bill of Complaint of George Richards of Frederick County, State of Maryland in behalf of himself and of all the other creditors of Thomas J Clagett late of Frederick County deceased who may come in and contribute to the expenses of this Bill respectfully shew to your Honors that the said Thomas J Clagett was indebted to your Complainant by his promissory note dated on the 1st day of April in the year 1873 for the sum of Sixty dollars and Eighty five cents payable sixty days after date with interest from date as well appear by reference to said promissory note herewith filed marked Exhibit A which your Complainant prays together with all other Exhibits hereinafter produced may be taken and considered as part of this his Bill of Complaint Your Complainant further charges that the said Thomas J Clagett died sometime in the month of June in the year 1873 seized and possessed of a tract of Land situate in Washington County State of Maryland being all that part of a tract or parcel of Land distinguished in the survey and division of a tract called "Antislam Work's" as Lot No 66, containing 25 Acres and 321 Square Perches of Land all of which will fully appear by reference to a certified copy of a deed from John Meredith and J. Spear Nicholas trustees to the said Thomas J. Clagett herewith Exhibited marked Exhibit No. 2.
