Your Complainant further charges that Dr John H Killary of Frederick County was appointed by the Orphans Court of Frederick County Administrator of the goods, chattels and personal Estate of the said Thomas J Cloggett dead, and that he has entered upon the discharge of his trust as well appear by reference to letters of Emplification herewith filed as Exhibit No. 3

Your Complainant further charges that the personal estate of the said Thomas J. Cloggett is wholly insufficient to pay his indebtedness and that it is necessary that his Real Estate be sold for the payment of the same To the end therefore that the Defendants hereinafter named may answer the matter and things heretofore stated the same as if they were herein again repeated and they were thereunto specially interrogated and that the Real Estate in the proceedings mentioned may be sold and the proceeds of said sale applied in payment of the claim of your Complainant with the interest due thereon and also in payment of the claims of all the other creditors of the said Thos J Cloggett who may come in and contribute to the expenses of this bill and that your Complainant may have such other and further relief in the premises as the nature and Equity of your Complainants case may require.

Now it please your Honors to grant unto your Complainant the writ of Subpoena against Dr John H Killary Administrator of the goods, chattels &c of said Thomas J Cloggett dead, Ann P Cloggett, Thos J Cloggett Mary Cloggett and Honora M Cloggett of Frederick County, commanding them to appear in this Court on some certain day to be therein named to answer the premises and to abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein, And as usual, &c

This Indenture made this 31st day of December in the year of our Lord 1858 between Jonathan Meredith and John Spear Nicholas of the City of Baltimore of the one part and Thomas J Cloggett of Frederick County Maryland of the other part, Whereas by a decree of the Honorable the Chancellor of Maryland passed on the 7th day of March 1848 in the case of Robert Selmer vs John McPherson Brown & wife & others the said Jonathan Meredith and John Spear Nicholas were appointed trustees to sell the Mortgaged Real Estate mentioned in the proceedings in said cause, and whereas on the 2nd day of June 1848 upon petition of the said Complainant the said trustees were by the order of the Chancellor of that date authorized and empowered to sell the said Mortgaged Real Estate at private as well as at public sale, and whereas the said Jonathan Meredith and John Spear Nicholas by virtue of the authority vested in them by the said decree and order did on the 15th day of June 1848 sell at private sale to the said John McPherson Brown at and for the sum of One hundred and ten thousand dollars the whole of the said Mortgaged Real Estate consisting of upwards of Thirteen thousand Acres of Land situated in Washington County and known by the name of the Antietam Iron Works as the same is
