To the Honorable the Judges of the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity,

Humbly complaining sheweth unto your Honors your Orator and Oratrix Abraham Hemp and Hannah Hemp his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, That a certain Juliana Hemp was in her life time seized and possessed of Real Estate lying and being in Frederick County aforesaid and conveyed to her, in separate parcels by Deeds executed respectively on the twelfth day of August Eighteen Hundred and fifty two and the twenty fifth day of April Eighteen hundred and fifty five, the one being made by a certain Sebastian Hansburg and being duly recorded in Liber C. B. No 4 folio 371 & 372, one of the land records of Frederick County aforesaid, the other being made by John Leaps & Henry Williams trustees and being duly recorded in Liber C. B. No 4 folio 151 one of the land records of Frederick County aforesaid. That on or about the month of April Eighteen Hundred and sixty one the said Juliana Hemp sold and conveyed to a certain John S. Morling a part of the land conveyed to her by the Deed last hereinbefore referred to, the said part so conveyed to said Morling being Lot No 7 in the Plat of Jefferson in said county, as appeared by a certified copy of said conveyance to said Morling herewith exhibited marked Exhibit No. 1, which as well as all other Exhibits herewith filed your Orator and Oratrix pray may be taken as part of this Bill as fully as if here at large in words and figures set forth. That the said Juliana Hemp so being seized as appears by certified copies of said conveyance except the land the said Lot No 7, so as aforesaid sold and conveyed to said Morling, did in the month of April Eighteen hundred and seventy four depart this life intestate leaving as her heirs at law and next of kind the following children and children of a dec<sup>d</sup> child to wit
