Hemp a son (married to Sarah Hemp, Amy Rebecca Hearst a Daughter and widow of Jacob Hearst & Dec & Ellen Lakin a Daughter and wife of William A. Lakin Martha Hemp widow of John Hemp a Dec & son of said Julianna, Frederick H. Hemp, Albert Hemp Alma C. Hemp, Harry Hemp and Ellen Hemp children of the said John Hemp a Dec & son of said Julianna,

That said Alma C., Harry and Ellen are infants under the age of twenty one years, and that all said Defendants except the said David Hemp and Eliza Jane his wife who are now residents of this State and do not live therein, reside in Frederick County Maryland. That said Real Estate is not susceptible of Division amongst them entitled thereto, without great loss and Damage and that it will be for the interest and advantage of all the parties infants and adults to sell said Real Estate and divide and distribute the proceeds amongst them entitled thereto. The Bill prays that a Decree may be passed for the sale of said Real Estate &c.

It is therefore Ordered this 3^d day of September A. D. 1874, that the Complainants cause a copy of this order together with the object and substance of the Bill to be inserted in some newspaper published in Frederick County once a week for four successive weeks before the 14th day of October, next giving notice to said David Hemp and the Eliza Jane Hemp his wife, two of the Defendants in said Bill and warning them to appear in person or by Solicitor in this Court or before the 14th day of January 1875, to show cause if any they have why a Decree should not pass as prayed.
