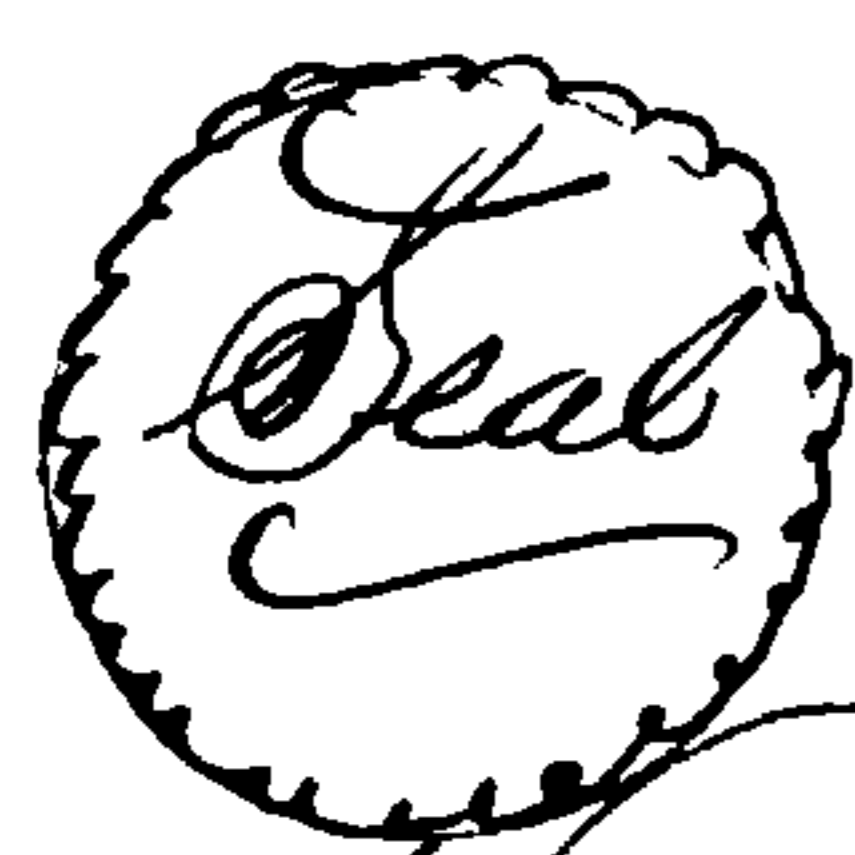
Sitting as a Court of Equity
