

September 1871, the said William Kuebel and James Kuebel appeared in writing said Mortgage to John White of Frederick County, and that being indebted to the Frederick County Building Association a body corporate of Frederick County in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars and twenty Dollars advanced on his share of its stock the said Martin K. Knode and Angelina Knode his wife on the tenth day of October in the year Eighteen Hundred and sixty Eight by Deed of Mortgage conveyed said fund to the said Frederick County Building Association to secure the Payment of the same, all of which will more fully and at large appear by reference to certified Copies of said Mortgage herewith Exhibited marked Exhibits No. 3 & 4. Your Complainant further charges that he has been informed and believes that said sums of money or large portions thereof intended to be secured by the Mortgage to the said Russell must have been held and owned by said William White and by the Frederick County Building Association remains still due and unpaid and are in some manner upon the Property mortgaged by said Martin K. Knode to said Jacob Haller.

Your Complainant further states that subsequently to the execution of the Mortgage to the said Jacob Haller the said Martin K. Knode being indebted to Lydia A. Hershey and Catharine C. Hershey of Montgomery County in the aggregate sum of Six hundred and four Dollars and fifty cents executed in conjunction with his wife Angelina Knode their of Mortgage dated on the eleventh day of November in the year Eighteen Hundred and sixty, to the said Lydia A. Hershey and Catharine C. Hershey conveying the same property premises mortgaged to said Jacob Haller for the purpose of securing the Payment of the said sums of money therein recited, all of which will more fully and at large appear by reference to a certified copy of said Mortgage herewith filed marked Exhibit No. 5.

Your Complainant further charges that said Jacob Haller died sometime in the month of August in the year Eighteen Hundred and seventy three and by his last Will and Testament appointed his wife Ann C. Haller sole Executrix of his said last Will, that said Ann C. Haller died on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of April 1874, and Letters of Administration on said Ann C. Haller were granted to your Complainant, who has filed in said Court his duly appointed Bond and entered upon the discharge of his Trust, as will appear by certified copies of Letters of exemplification herewith filed marked Exhibit No. 6.

To the end thereof that the said Martin K. Knode and Angelina Knode his wife, William White, the Frederick County Building Association, Lydia A. Hershey and Catharine C. Hershey may answer the several matters and things herein before stated, as fully as if they were herein again repeated and they were thereunto specially interrogated, and that said William L. Haller Administrator as aforesaid of Jacob Haller may redeem the former Mortgage respectively held by William White and the Frederick County Building Association and that said Lydia A. Hershey and Catharine C. Hershey the subsequent Mortgagees of said Martin K. Knode may redeem, and that said Martin K. Knode the Knodes the Mortgages may also redeem said Mortgages or upon the failure of either of said Parties to redeem as aforesaid, then that the Real Estate mentioned in the Proceedings be sold under and by virtue of a Decree of your Honor's Court for the Payment of the said Mortgage debts with the interest due thereon
