This Mortgage made this thirtieth day of July in the year Eighteen Hundred and sixty nine by Martin R. Knode and Angelina Knode his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland,

Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of five Hundred dollars with interest thereon from the date hereof now owing from the said Martin R. Knode to Jacob Haller, the said Martin R. Knode and Angelina Knode his wife do grant unto the said Jacob Haller all that Real Estate upon which the said Martin R. Knode now resides situate lying and being in New Market District in Frederick County in the State of Maryland and containing eighty eight acres of land more or less. Provided that if the said Martin R. Knode shall pay on or before the thirtieth day of July in the year Eighteen hundred and seventy to the said Jacob Haller the sum of Five Hundred dollars
