This Mortgage made this Eleventh day of November in the year Eighteen hundred and Seventy by us Martin R. Kenode and Angelina Kenode his wife of Frederick County in State of Maryland Witness that in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred and five dollars and fifty cents now due from us the said Martin R. Kenode to Lydia A. Horshey of Montgomery County in the State of Maryland upon a promissory note of even date herewith payable six months after date to the said Lydia A. Horshey or order and also in consideration of the sum of Two hundred Dollars now due from us the said Martin R. Kenode to Catharine E. Horshey also of Montgomery in the State aforesaid upon a promissory note of even date herewith payable six months after date to the said Catharine E. Horshey or order

We the said Martin R. Kenode and Angelina Kenode his wife do grant in fee simple unto the said Lydia A. Horshey and Catharine E. Horshey all their parts of tracts or parcels of land situate lying and being in Frederick County State of Maryland being part of a tract of land called "The Reserve on Wild Cat Hill" part of a tract called "New Market Plains" and part of a tract of land called "The Reserve on the Meadows" which is mentioned and described in the Deed from William Russell and Susan S. Russell his wife and James Russell to Martin R. Kenode dated the second day of March in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty seven and recorded in land records of Frederick County in Liber C, No. 1, folio 279 &c, as by reference thereto will fully and at large appear.

And the said Martin R. Kenode doth also in consideration of said several sums of money hereby bargain and sell unto the said Lydia A. Horshey and Catharine E. Horshey the following Property, to wit: One black Mare "coll" one brown Mare "sal" One Brown Mare "Tom" One mouse colored Mare Julia one hindle Bull, One Black and white spotted cow, and One red cow, twenty head of sheep, Eight head of stock Hogs, One four wheel wagon, One three wheel wagon two spring wagons, One Cart, two two horse plows One three horse plow four double horse plows, three single horse plows (Provided that if the said Catharine R. Kenode shall pay on or before the 11th day of May in the year Eighteen hundred and seventy one, to the said Lydia A. Horshey the sum of Four hundred and five Dollars and fifty cents with the interest thereon
