To the Honorable the Judges of the Sixth Judicial Circuit of the State of Maryland in and for the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity.

The Bill of Complaint of Abraham Shoff and Mary M Shoff his wife and Luther Shoff and Mary E. Shoff his wife of Frederick County State of Maryland respectfully shew unto your Honorable Court that heretofore to wit on or about the 15. day of March in the year A.D. 1874 in the County and State aforesaid, a certain George Shoff died intestate seized and possessed of certain real estate situated in the County and State aforesaid

Your Prayers further shew that the said George Shoff deceased left surviving him as his children and heirs at law your Complainants said Abraham Shoff, your Complainant Luther Shoff, who married Mary E. Shoff, John Shoff who is married to Rebecca Shoff, Solomon Shoff married to Sarah W. Shoff, Francis Shoff married to Lenora Shoff Jacob Shoff, Mary E. Shoff who married a certain Isaac N. Fry, and M. Gore who married a certain Charles B. Gore in all six sons and two daughters all of whom are over twenty one year of age and reside in Frederick County State of Maryland.

Your Complainants further shew that they did on the 16. day of March in the year A. D. 1874 file a Bill of Complaint in the Circuit Court for Frederick County for the sale of the said real estate of the said George Shoff of which he died seized and possessed, but in describing the said lands of said George Shoff failed to set out and describe in said Bill of Complaint a certain lot situated in the village of Jefferson adjoining certain lands of a certain Juliana Ann Shoff who was the wife of said George Shoff, but who died some years prior to death of said George Shoff.

Your Prayers charge that to prevent any cloud on the title to the land they have determined to file this their Bill of Complaint to obtain a Decree for
