

2nd Int. I have known the parties for some years.

3rd Int. I did, he is dead, he died near Liberty, Frederick County Maryland ten or twelve years ago.

4th Int. I do, it consists of about sixty two acres of land situated in Frederick County Maryland and is worth about twenty five dollars per acre, I look at "Exhibit No. 1" now here shown me said Christian Hostler did seized and possessed of the Real Estate therein described.

5th Int. He left a will.

6th Int. He did leave a widow now living named Barbara Hostler about sixty three years of age residing in Johnsville District Frederick County Maryland, Her health is good.


7th Int. He left children as follows namely Thaddeus S Hostler residing in Frederick County Md Maria C married to John H Barber and residing in Frederick County Md Lamma S married to William S Kiehl and residing in Frederick County Md Sidney Ann married to Henry Sawyer and residing in Frederick County Md Lucy A married to Moses Fostle and residing in Pennsylvania, Elizabeth deceased married to John Carl who resides in Pennsylvania, Amanda deceased married to Abraham Kiehl who resides in Frederick County Md, All are Adults.

8th Int. Amanda Kiehl died in Frederick County Md, a not seven years ago Elizabeth Carl died in Pennsylvania two years ago last spring said Amanda left a husband surviving her named Abraham Kiehl but left no children. Elizabeth left a husband surviving her named John Carl and the following children namely Calvin Martin Ellen Sarah and Lilly Carl all infants under the age of twenty one years and all residing in the State of Pennsylvania.

9th Int. Said Real Estate is not susceptible of advantageous division among the parties interested as it consists of sixty one or sixty two acres of land and if divided the parcels would be too small for advantageous cultivation or sale, and it would be for the benefit and advantage of all parties concerned infants as well as adults that said Real Estate should be sold and the proceeds thereof distributed among the parties entitled.

10th Int. I know nothing further.
