

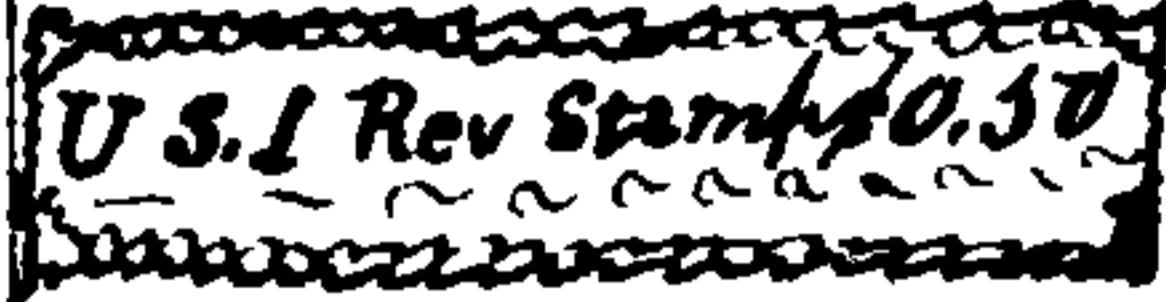

This Mortgage made this 29th day of April in the year of our Lord 1871 by us Lycourgue Miller and Lucinda E Miller his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and Ninety dollars now owing from me to said Lycourgue Miller to Jacob Birely of said County on four promissory notes dated April the 1st 1871 and said notes are each for the sum of Seventytwo dollars and fifty cents with interest from date payable in one two three and four years after date to secure the payment of said several promissory notes we the said Lycourgue Miller Lucinda E Miller his wife do grant unto the said Jacob Birely all of the part of a tract or parcel of Land which is fully described in a deed of conveyance bearing date of this day from Jacob Birely and Hannah Mary Birely his wife and Fredericks Birely to said Lycourgue Miller. Provided that if we the said Lycourgue Miller and Lucinda E Miller his wife shall pay on or before the 1st day of April 1875 the sum of Two hundred and Ninety dollars with the interest thereon as mentioned in its said promissory notes then this Mortgage shall be void

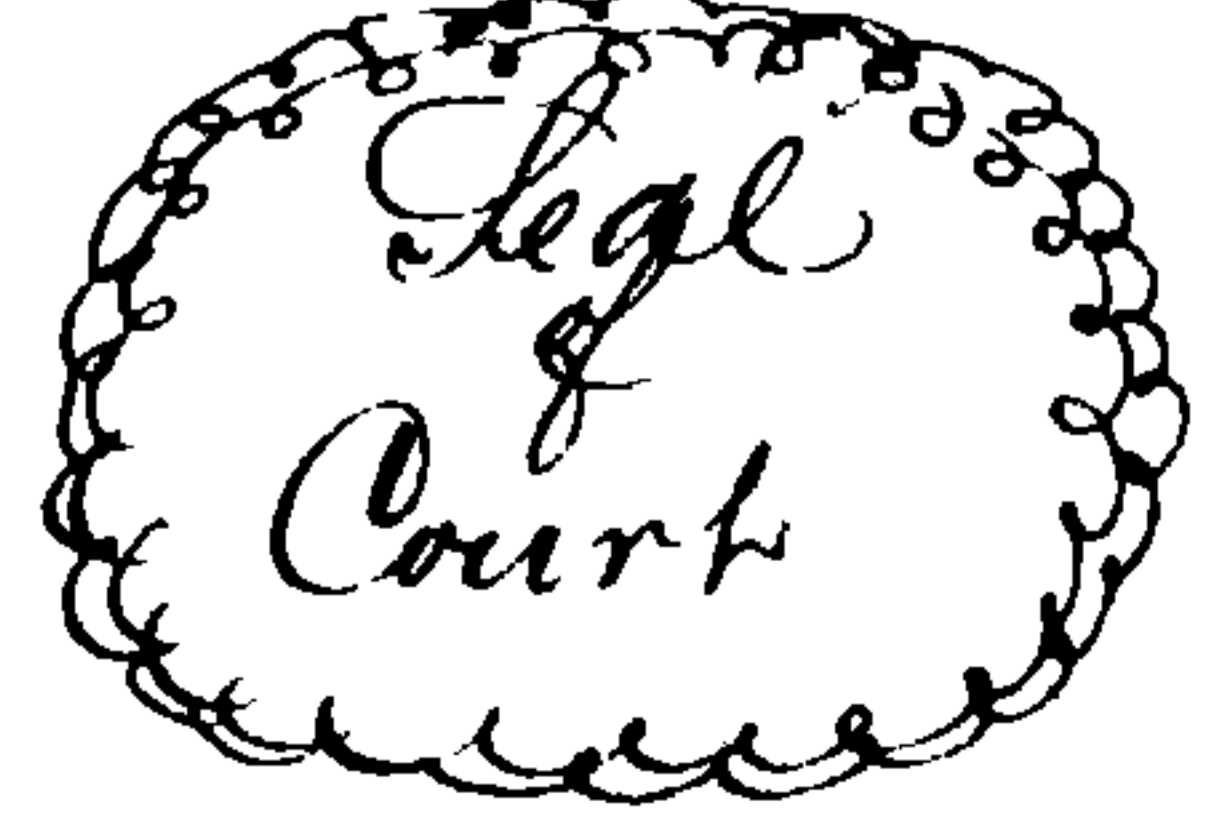
