In the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting in Equity  
May Term 1875

The object of this bill filed in this case is to procure a Decree for sale of certain mortgaged premises in Frederick County which were on the 29th day of April A. D. 1871 mortgaged by Defendants Lycourgue Miller and Lucinda E Miller his wife to the Complainant Jacob Birely.

The bill states that on the 29th day of April A. D. 1871 the said Lycourgue Miller and Lucinda E Miller his wife who were then residents of Frederick County but are now non-residents of the State of Maryland conveyed unto the Complainant Jacob Birely certain real estate which is particularly described in the bill by way of Mortgage to secure the payment of four promissory notes amounting in the aggregate to two hundred and ninety dollars with interest from the 1st day of April A. D. 1871. The bill then states that the time for the payment of the Mortgage debt has passed, that the same is due and wholly unpaid both as to principal and interest, that suit was instituted on one of said notes and judgment obtained, but nothing realized thereon. The bill then prays for a sale of the property to pay the Mortgage debt and for general relief a certified copy of the Mortgage and three of said promissory notes are filed as Exhibits to the Bill

It is thereupon adjudged and ordered this 13th day of August A. D. 1875, that the Complainant by causing a copy of this order to be inserted in some newspaper published in Frederick County once a week for four successive weeks before the 18th day of September A. D. 1875 gives notice to the said absent Defendants of the substance and object of the bill filed in this case and warn them to appear in this Court in person or by Solicitor on or before the 20th day of December A. D. 1875 and show cause if any they have why the relief prayed should not be granted.
