The Petition and Report of Sales of John W Buggard  
George Leatherman and Joseph Brown of Frederick County in the State of Maryland  
respectfully represents that on the 26th day of February in the year 1870 a certain  
Daniel Michael and Mary A Michael his wife of Frederick County by Deed of Trust  
duly executed and acknowledged conveyed unto your Petitioners as trustees for the benefit  
of the creditors of the said Daniel Michael all the Real Estate and all the Personal  
Property and evidences of indebtedness of which said Daniel Michael was seized  
and possessed at the date of the execution of said Deed of Trust save and  
except such as is by law exempt from execution under the laws of the State of Maryland  
with power to sell as much thereof as is salable at either public or private sale  
upon such terms and notice and at such time and place as your Petitioners should  
deem best and to collect so much as is collectable and to apply the proceeds of such  
sales and collections as is specified fully in said Deed of Trust and in such  
manner as is therein specified as well more fully and at large appear from  
a certified copy of said Deed of Trust herewith filed marked Exhibit No 1  
which with all other Exhibits hereinafter produced or hereafter to be produced  
your Petitioners pray may be taken as part of their petition and report of sales

Your Petitioners further state that they are advised that they are entitled  
to come into your Honorable Court wherein matters of this kind are prop-  
erly cognizable and to distribute the trust funds under the direction of this  
Court, they therefore report their sales under said Deed of Trust to this Court  
and respectfully pray your Honorable Court to ratify said sales and to  
direct them in the distribution of the funds. Your Trustees further state  
that after having given bond to the State of Maryland in such sum as has  
been approved by the Clerk of this Court and after having notice of the time
