This Mortgage made this 1st day of November in the year 1807 by John H. Fogle of Frederick County in the State of Maryland Witnesseth that in consideration of three hundred and twenty dollars now due from me to Joseph Moleworth of the County and State aforesaid, I the said John H. Fogle do hereby grant unto the said Joseph Moleworth all the following property to wit: all that piece parcel and part of a tract of Land lying and being in the County aforesaid being part of a tract of land called "Reunvey on Monk" and adjoining the lands of Regim Davis, Benjamin Corner, and Mary Enticis and containing 124 Acres of Land more or less it being the same property heretofore conveyed to the said John H. Fogle by Perin Barnes by Deed bearing date the 30th day of October A. D. 1806 and recorded in Liber J. W. L. C. No folio 416 One of the Land Records of Frederick County Provided that if I the said John H. Fogle shall pay on or before the 1st day of November in the year 1808 to the said Joseph Moleworth the sum of three hundred and twenty dollars with legal interest thereon then this Mortgage shall be void and provided further that in case I the said John H. Fogle shall make default in the payment of the said sum of three hundred and twenty dollars or the interest thereon as aforesaid then it shall be lawful for the said Joseph Moleworth to make sale of said Mortgaged Premises at Public Sale after three weeks notice of the time place and manner and terms of sale by advertisement in some newspaper printed in Frederick town and shall apply the proceeds of sale to the payment of the said Mortgage debt
