This cause standing now upon the Bill of Complaint and Exhibits therewith filed and the answer of the infant Respondents by their Guardian appointed under a Commission of the said Court to take said answers and the answer of the adult Defendants by their Solicitor It is therefore this 10th day of May 1871 hereby agreed by us John E R Wood Solicitor for the Complainant herein and James W Barre Solicitor for the adult Defendants herein that the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity, if the said Court shall be of opinion that it is best for the infant Defendants herein and best for the interests of said infants so to do should pass a decree in this cause for the sale of that part and portion of said Real Estate mentioned in said Bill of complaint that was occupied by Mary Entwail widow of Peter Entwail mentioned in said Bill of complaint during her life the same being about 50 Acres of land more or less and one third part of the land and Real Estate of the said Peter Entwail of which he died seized and possessed the balance of said Land being 100 Acres thereof having been sold, as is admitted and alleged in said Bill by Henry Steer the Executor of said Peter Entwail under the provisions of the last Will and Testament of the said Peter to David W Barnes and afterwards by him sold to John W Fogle one of the adult Defendants in this cause And it is hereby further agreed by the said Solicitors that the proceeds of the sale of the said 50 acres of land after the payment of the expenses incurred and to be yet incurred in this proceeding including Commissions to Trustee or Trustees who shall be appointed by the Court to make sale of the same shall be equally divided among the children of Sally Entwail mentioned in said Bill of complaint to wit the Complainant William P Thompson and the infant Defendants in this cause.
