This Deed made this 18th day of May in the year 1868 by John Smith of Frederick County in the State of Maryland Witnesseth that in consideration of love and natural affection for my wife Mary M Smith and for the purpose of making a provision for her support and maintenance which I may justly and legally make being free and clear from debts and having other property more than sufficient to pay any claim or liabilities against me I the said John Smith do grant unto her Mary M Smith my wife to have and to hold as feme sole with full power to sell and convey the same by Deed, Mortgage or other conveyance and without my joining therewith if she shall so desire to use the same as her sole and separate property without interference from me or any person or persons claiming by from or through me, all that piece or portion of ground lying and being in Frederick County Maryland and which is described in a Deed from Henry Smith to John Smith recorded March 25. 1857 in Liber E. f. No. 9 Folio 323, being part of a tract of Land called "Strokers Timber Land" Beginning at a stone marked H. f. standing in the middle of the Public Road leading from Burkittsville to "Bate Post" running thence from said stone N. 77 1/2° 31 1/2' to a stone N. 58° 9' 31 1/2' to a stone S. 28 1/4° W 29' to a stone S. 56 1/2° E 36 1/2' to the place of beginning excepting and reserving thereout so much thereof as was conveyed by me to John W Smith by Deed dated August 24. 1867 and recorded in Liber D. f. B No. Folio 634 One of the Land Records of Frederick County
