Testimony

At the execution of the within Commission issued out of the Circuit Court for Frederick County and to me directed and empowering me to examine evidences in the cause therein depending between George A Hoover as Complainant, and Clara V Harry, Charles Harry and Armemo Harry, as Defendants I William P Kelton Commissioner therein named, did on the 5th day of January A.D. 1877 at my Office in Frederick City Md in the absence of John E. R. Wood Commissioner then and there proceed to take the following testimony to wit:

The Complainant filed with the Commissioner evidence "Exhibits Nos. 1, 2, & 3" which are herewith returned by the said Commissioner, and there being no witnesses present to be examined and further time being required for the production of evidence the Commission was adjourned to the 12th day of January A.D. 1877 at which time and at the place aforesaid I then and there in the absence of John E. R. Wood Commissioner so proceeded to take the following depositions to wit:

George A Hoover, a witness of lawful age produced upon the part of the Complainant being duly affirmed to interrogatories filed with the Commissioner by the Complainant and herewith returned, deposes and says,

to the

to 1st Int I know all of the parties to this suit and have known them all for some years

to 2nd Int. I did, she is dead, she died at Graceham Frederick County Maryland in the fall of the year 1875

to 3rd Int She died intestate

to 4th Int. She left the following children namely Clara V Harry adult and residing in Baltimore City Md Charles A Harry adult & residing in Frederick County Md and Armemo R Harry, an infant under the age of twenty one years and residing in Frederick County Maryland.

to 5th Int She left a small Personal Estate, there has been Administration on the same in the Orphans Court of Frederick County Maryland, deponent is the Administrator.

to 6th Int. It was not sufficient to pay her debts, the Personal Estate amounted
