to 8th Int It was devised to her by the Will of her husband Parmenio R Harry, dec'd as appears by "Exhibit No 3" filed in this case.

to 9th Int She was, by a promissory note for \$54.75, dated March 27th 1869 as well, appear by "Exhibit No 1" filed in this case, said indebtedness has not been paid and is still due except the sum of One dollar (\$1) which is credited on said notes

to 10th Int I know nothing further

William J Black, a witness of lawful age produced upon the part of the Complainant being duly sworn and examined to Interrogatories filed with the Commissioner by the Complainant & herewith returned, deposes and says, to the

1st Int I am acquainted with all of the parties to this suit, and have known them all for some years.

to 2nd Int I did, she is dead, she died in Graceham Frederick County Maryland in the fall of the year 1875

to 3rd Int She died intestate.

to 4th Int She left children as follows, namely: Clara D Harry adult and residing in Baltimore City Md. Charles A Harry adult and residing in Frederick County Md and Parmenio R Harry an infant under twenty one years of age who resides in Frederick Co. Md.

to 5th Int. She left a small Personal Estate upon which Administration has been granted by the Orphans Court for Frederick County Maryland, George A Hoover Complainant, is such Administrator.

to 6th Int. The amount of the Personal Estate is about \$120. I don't know the amount of debts due by her Estate

to 7th Int. She did, she left a House and small Lot, situate in Graceham Frederick County Maryland and worth from \$600. to \$800.

to 8th Int It was devised to her by the last Will and Testament of her Parmenio R Harry, deceased as appears by "Exhibit No 3" filed in this case

to 9th Int I am unable to answer this Interrogatory, as I am not acquainted with said Elizabeth Harry's handwriting and know nothing in regard to the transaction between the said Elizabeth Harry deceased and the Complainant in this case

to 10th Int I know nothing further

Whereupon there being no other witnesses present to be examined and no further time being required for the production of evidence the Commissioner closed the said Commission & herewith returns the same under his hand & seal this 13th day of January A D 1877
