

Answer, Very little conversation passed between me and him and the death of my brother Isaac saw him until several days after my brother Benjamin was buried, I say him at the time he gave up the papers of my brother to Mrs Judd the Executor; I don't recollect it being him again until he came to my house, there was a smart snow upon the ground it was sometime in the last of January or first of February 1867, he came over, much excited and said Sam, I want to borrow your horse, I told him he could have him, but I had nothing but a blind bridle, he appeared to be in a great hurry, I told him if he would go to the stable with me, he could get the creature, when he stepped out of the stable he said to me Sam, you have ruined me, in reply, I said how dear brother Rachel what have I done, if you had given up those Coupons this trouble would not have been on you, we went on to the stable, I got my creature for him and at the same time there was a black man that was known with Mrs Judd at that time, he came up and said Master Sam Mr. Magfield sent me over to get you to come and a first him about some papers, brother Rachel then accosted the Negro, and asked him if he saw any body about the Mill as he passed, the Negro's reply was there was a Stepligh there and some gentleman with Mr. Magfield whom he he did not know he then had some conversation with the Negro; gave him some money and told him not to pay anything, that he had been him, he then mounted my creature, shook hands and started.
