8th Int. During the conversation to which you have just testified, was there or not any thing said to you, or either of you in reference to a Deed, that had been executed by Benjamin Todd and yourself to Benjamin St. and Jesse C. Todd?
Answer. There was not.

9th Int. Who if any one, went with you to the store of Miss Ringrose?
Answer. Mrs. Mother went with me.

10th Int. How far were your Mother and you apart during the time you were in said store?
Answer. We were close together.

11th Int. Was or not your Mother near enough to you to hear all conversation that passed between you and any one else while in said store??
Ans. She was.

12th Int. Did you in said store or any where else ever say to Miss Margaret Ringrose, or any one else that you were perfectly satisfied with your act, in having signed the Deed with your Husband Benjamin Todd, to Benjamin St. and Jesse C. Todd, that they were his Grandchildren and ought to have the Property mentioned in said Deed, or any words of like tenor or effect?
Ans. I never did.

13th Int. What was your acquaintance, if any, with Miss Margaret Ringrose, before the 1st of December 1866?
Ans. I never had any acquaintance, with her.

14th Int. Did you or not ever say to your late Husband B. Todd, or to any one else, in the presence of Harriet M. Todd or in the presence of any one else that you desired no interest in the Frederick County lands, or that you did not want the old Bills and doles, or any thing of like tenor or effect?

15th Int. Did you consult counsel in reference to the Deed here in question and if you; whom and how long after the death of Benjamin Todd?
