It is therefore from this 17th day of December A.D. 1875 by the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity by the authority thereof, adjudged Ordered and decreed that said account No. 3. be and the same is hereby Ratified and confirmed; and it is further adjudged Ordered and decreed that accounts No. 1. and No. 2. be and they are hereby Rejected

Mundle at the time of his death was seized and possessed in fee simple of several large and valuable parcels or tracts of land situated lying and being in Frederick County, a full description of which will be fully seen from the Copies of the deeds for the same herewith filed and marked Exhibits
