

Whereas I John Derr of Frederick County, did on the 14th. day of December 1829, make & publish the within as my last Will & Testament, yet being anxious to make certain alterations therein to for that purpose make this Codicil to said last Will & Testament & intend that it shall be part thereof as if the bequests & legacies herein named & mentioned had been inserted therein at the time of the publication of said last Will and Testament.

First, In addition to the legacies bequeathed by me in my said will to my daughters Elizabeth Getzendanner wife of Jonathan Getzendanner & Polly Getzendanner wife of Daniel Getzendanner, I give & devise to each of them as follows, One Thousand Dollars to each of them to be paid in one year after my decease by my son & devisee John Derr, One Thousand Dollars each in two years after my decease, One Thousand Dollars each in three years after my decease, & the further sum of Five Hundred Dollars each in four years after my decease, that is to say One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars to each of the said daughters Elizabeth & Polly or seven Thousand Dollars in addition to the several Legacies contained in my will for the payment whereof I hereby bind the estate heretofore devised to my son John in as full & ample a manner as the same is already bound for the payment of their other Legacies & as though I had in said will devised to them the additional sums herein bequeathed.

Second, Having in the third clause of my will devised to my daughter Catharine the tract of Land therein named it is my will and desire that in addition thereto her husband may during the lifetime of my said daughter but no longer cut & use as much timber & wood on said land as may be necessary for rails, firewood & the support of the place, but not to sell or haul away any except for the purposes herein set forth & enumerated.

In testimony that this is a Codicil to my last will & testament & to be taken as part thereof I hereunto set my hand & affix my seal March 13<sup>th</sup>. 1833,
