Humblly Complainng sheweth unto your Honors, your Orators and
Oratrices John J. Smith and Maria Smith his wife, all of Frederick
County, in the State of Maryland, that heretofore to wit: Some time
in the month of January in the year eighteen hundred and twenty
five, a certain John Smith of L late of Frederick County aforesaid,
departed this life intestate seized and possessed of certain real
estate lying and being in said County and described in sundry
deeds of conveyance, the first whereof bearing date the twentieth
day of November, Eighteen hundred and twenty, and recorded in Liber
H. S. No 3. folio 53, one of the Land Records of said County, conveyed
