At the request of William Strine the following Deed is recorded 7th day of March 1878, to wit:  
This Indenture, made this fourth day of October Eighteen hundred and Seventeen by and between Peter Iser and Barbara Iser his wife, of the one part, and William Strine of the other part, all of Frederick County, and State of Maryland, Witnesseth, that the said Peter Iser and Barbara his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Sixteen dollars current money to them in hand paid by the said William Strine the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath bargained and sold unto the said William Strine his heirs and assigns all their right and title of in and to a certain Lot of ground in the "Fox Mounting", adjoining Land of Conrad Iser, containing fifteen acres more or less being a Lot of ground formerly bought of William Hater by a certain Peter Strine together with all their or either of them right or title in Law or
