Exhibit No. 3. At the request of Addison White the following Deed is recorded April 27th, 1847.
This Indenture, made this 5th day of April, in the year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty seven, between William N. Harris and Sarah Harris his wife, of Montgomery County, in the State of Maryland, of the one part, and Addison White of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, of the other part, Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Fifty nine dollars current money by the said Addison White to the said William N. Harris and Sarah Harris, his wife, in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt of which they do hereby acknowledge the said William N. Harris and Sarah Harris, his wife, have bargained and sold, aliened and conveyed and by these presents do give, grant bargain and sell, alien, conveyed, release, convey and confer unto the said Addison White, his heirs and assigns all that tract of land being part of "The Resurvey on Little North", Situate, lying and being in Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, and designated on a plat made by Nelly James Dec. 8, 1832, as Lot No. 27. Beginning at a stone marked B, Lot No. 4 and running thence S. 37 1/4° W 106 yds to a stone marked No. 112, thence S. 48 1/2° E 121 yds to a stone marked No. 113, thence N 15 1/2° E. 66 yds. to a stone marked No. 114, thence N. 25° E 96 yds. to a stone marked No. 115, thence N. 4: W 46 yds to a
