To the Honorable the Judges of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as a Court of Equity:  
 The Bell of Complaint of James W. Eichelberger of Frederick County, who sues as well for himself as all other creditors of Mary M. Honck late of said County deceased, who will come in and contribute to the expenses of this suit humbly shews, that a certain Mary M. Honck late of Frederick County, deceased was in her lifetime indebted unto your Complainant in the sum of Five Hundred and Eleven Dollars for medical attendance, and for sundry matters and things properly chargeable in account, and your Complainant files as part of his bill of Complaint a copy of said account duly sworn to marked Exhibit No 1. which with all other Exhibits herewith filed he prays may be taken as part of his bill of Complaint Your Complainant further charges that the said Mary M. Honck being indebted unto your Complainant as aforesaid and possibly to divers other persons in various sums of money, and having real and personal estate departed this life in or about the year Eighteen hundred and seventy three leaving a will and testament, unaltered and unrevoked whereby she willed and bequeathed to her son Vincent Myers for his support during his natural life all that real estate she did seize and possessed of being and lying in Emmittsburg District, Frederick County, Maryland in part, the other part lying and being in Liberty township, Adams County, and State of Pennsylvania along with all her household and kitchen furniture, in short she all the property she did seize of Real, Personal and Mixed, for the sole use of said Vincent Myers, the same to be sold for the support of Vincent Myers if in the discretion of the executor he should consider it necessary and apply the proceeds
