At the request of Ezekiah Botter the following Deed was Recorded December 9th, 1857.

This Deed made this 16th day of October in the year Eighteen hundred and fifty seven, between Geo W. Crum, Justice, as hereinafter mentioned and Ezekiah Botter, Witness, Thomas, Mrs. B. Stabler by his Deed bearing date June 9th, 1857, recorded in Liber E. J. No. 10. folio 392 & 393, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, conveyed to the said Geo W. Crum, the property hereafter mentioned in trust to sell the same for certain purposes in said Deed expressed, and whereas, the said Geo. W. Crum in pursuance of the power so vested in him, did on the 1st of July 1857, sell to the said Ezekiah Botter, the property hereinafter mentioned and conveyed at and for the sum of Nineteen dollars, and whereas, the whole of said purchase money has been fully paid & satisfied — Now therefore in consideration of the premises the said Geo W. Crum, doth grant unto the Ezekiah Botter, all that Lot or portion of ground, lying in the Town of Newsville, in Frederick County, State of Maryland, known and distinguished on the Plat of said Town
