Humbly Complaining sheweth unto your Honor your orator Charles Myers, and your oratrix Ellen Myers of Lancaster County, in the State of Pennsylvania, but who being infants sue by Abraham A. Myers, their guardian, and your orator John W Lowell and your oratrix Kate Lowell, his wife, both of Lancaster County aforesaid, that a certain William Lowell late of Frederick County, deceased, was in his life time seized and possessed of a certain house and lot of ground lying and being in Frederick City, in Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, which is described in Exhibit A. herewith filed and prayed to be taken and considered as fact of this Bill of Complaint, that being so seized and possessed thereof, he the said William Lowell did on or about the 20th. day of November, in the year Eighteen Hundred and seventy one, make, publish and declare his last will and testament, a certified copy whereof is herewith filed marked Exhibit B. wherein and whereby he devised all his Estate to the following persons James Lowell, Charles Myers, Ellen Myers, John Lowell, Ellen Kolb, Rose Cooper, Charles Lowell and Mary Hagan, that is to say to each of said devisees, one seventh of his entire Estate That the said William Lowell was possessed of but little personal estate and that the property owned by him at the time of his death consisted chiefly of the said house and lot of ground That in and by said will he left no person empowered to sell said real estate, and your orator and oratrix are advised that the said devisees hold the said real estate in common under the provisions of said will Your orator and oratrix pray that said real estate is not susceptible of partition or division
