The Second Report of Sales, of Wm. G. Baker and Charles M. Ross, Trustees of Daniel S. Jones respectfully reports to your Honors, that since their last report of sales, they have sold at Private Sale, the Mill Property known as the Three Spring Mills, situate in Frederick County, State of Maryland, on the road leading to Green Spring Mills, together with the improvements and appurtenances thereto belonging to Archibald J. Snodgrass et. and for the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars, and upon the following terms: Five Thousand Dollars to be paid on the first day of October 1878, with interest from the first day of April 1878, and the residue in two Equal Payments in one and two years from the date of sale, bearing interest from the first day of April 1878.
