At the request of Nancy Barriek the following Mortgage was recorded April 9th, 1866.

This Mortgage made the second day of April, in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and sixty six, Whereas, Abraham Danner stands indebted by his promissory note bearing date with this Mortgage duly stamped, according to the act of Congress, payable two years after date bearing interest from date, interest to be paid annually for the sum of Fifteen hundred dollars as by reference to note will fully appear. Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the above, the said Abraham Danner and Dorothy Danner, his wife. Do grant unto Nancy Barriek the payee of said note all of that part of a tract of land, containing One hundred and forty three acres, 3 rods and 36 perches of land more or less, situate and lying in Frederick County, Maryland, it being the same tract that was conveyed by John Philip Beard to Abraham Danner by deed bearing date October 2nd 1856 and recorded in Liber B. G. J. No. 1 folio 60, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, and also the same tract as described in Mortgage bearing date 14th. March 1864, from Abraham Danner to Christian Barriek and recorded in Liber J. W. B. C. No. 1 folio 230, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, which will fully show. Provided, that if the said Abraham Danner shall pay on or before the second day of April in the year 1868, unto the said Nancy Barriek the sum of Fifteen hundred dollars, and the interest thereon annually according to the tenor and effect of the said promissory note herein recited, then this Mortgage shall be void.
