The petition of R. Emory Simmons father and next friend of
of Susan Elizabeth Simmons, M. Virginia Simmons and Jas.
Samuel Simmons of Frederick County, respectfully shew unto your
honors that your petitioner in his own right was the owner of
seventy three undivided ninety sixths of a tract of land sit-
uated in Frederick County being part of "The Resurvey on Simp-
son's Chance", and part of "The Grove", containing one hundred
and thirty one and one half acres of land, more or less, and
being the same land conveyed to your petitioner by Geo. H. Paley
and others by deed dated the 24th day of March A. D. 1860,
a copy of which is filed herewith as Exhibit No. 1, and which
with all other Exhibits herewith filed is prayed to be taken as
part of this petition as fully as if here inserted in words and
figures, except about one acre and a half sold by your Pet-
itioner to Richard Valentine, but not conveyed; and Sarah E.
Simmons the wife of your Petitioner was the owner of the other un-
divided twenty three ninety sixths of said tract of land conveyed
to her by Serena Simmons by deed dated the 30th day of
March A. D. 1860, a copy of which is filed herewith as Exhibit
