5<sup>th</sup>. Int: What were you to do, and what to furnish for the \$1700?

Ans: We were to do everything to the house except the digging and putting up the foundation and the plastering. I was to furnish all the materials for erecting and building the same, except those used in the foundation and plastering work.

6<sup>th</sup>. Int: You say you made out a bill amounting to \$1700, which was agreed upon. Have you that bill? Is it on a paper, or in a book? If in a book, file a copy of it?

Ans: I have. It's in a book that we had, at that time, to take down orders for work in the shop.

Compt'rs. have filed "Exhibit L. R. N.", which is herewith returned by the Commission.)

7<sup>th</sup>. Int: When was that entry made in your book?

Ans: I am unable to say. I made out the bill on a piece of paper - then I copied the bill in a book from said paper, and I believe "Exhibit L. R. N." is a true copy of the original estimate of \$1700 - I showed the paper to Mr. Sefton and I don't know where the paper is - I think it's lost - It is not in my possession that I know of. The entry was made in the book before we commenced work on the house.

8<sup>th</sup>. Int: How soon after the contract did you begin work in the house?

Ans: I am not able to say.

9<sup>th</sup>. Int: Where is the lot situated upon which said house was to be built? Look at paper shown you marked Exhibit No. 1, and say if that describes the lot, and is the lot referred to?

Ans: Several hundred yards back of the United Brethren Church in Mechanicstown. It adjoins the lands of Mr. James Burger. I look at Exhibit No. 1, now here shown me - Said Exhibit properly describes the lot and is the one referred to.

10<sup>th</sup>. Int: Did you or not build said house in accordance with your contract?

Ans: To the best of my ability. I did, except what was afterwards ordered different.

11<sup>th</sup>. Int: Describe said house and look at Exhibit No. 1, and say if the description there given is correct and is the house referred to.

12<sup>th</sup>. Int: What changes were made in the original plan as agreed upon by order of Mr. Sefton, and what extra work, if any, was done by you by his order?

Ans: I think there was a back stairway put up from the kitchen to the upper story - and stairs from underneath the same to the cellar - Then there was an extra door and frame put in from the outside of the house into the kitchen - There was a lot of shelving put up in the closet under the stairway - There was a partition taken down and moved.

13<sup>th</sup>. Int: Did you or not do any other work upon said house?

Ans: I finished the plastering which Sefton's plasterer failed to do,
