At the request of James Hemes the following deed was recorded May 26th, 1853. Received \$1. Stamp duty, Test: E. Shinn, etc. This Indenture, made this 26th day of May, 1853, between George Innescott and Hannah Rosetta, his wife, of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, of the one part, and James Hemes of the same place of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said George Innescott and Hannah Rosetta, his wife, in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and fifty dollars, current money, to the said George in hand paid by the said James, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell, alien, enfeoff and confirm unto the said James Hemes, all that piece or Lot of ground in Frederick Town, which was conveyed to the said George Innescott by Francis Thomas, Justice under a Writ of Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity, by Deed of the said Francis Thomas, Justice, as aforesaid dated the 12th day of February, 1853, and recorded in Liber C. S. No. 1. folios 654 & 606 one of the Land Records of Frederick County, which said Lot fronts on East Street fifty feet and running back One hundred and fifty, and being Eighteen feet on the northerly road leading from Frederick Town to Manocay, and lying next to and adjoining the lot belonging to Richard Potts on said Street.
