This Deed, made this 23rd day of March, in the year One thousand
eight hundred and sixty six, by Daniel Warrenfette, Trustee, for the
sale of the Real Estate of Magdalena Sinsbaugh, late of Frederick County
deceased, Witnesseth, that by virtue of a Commission issued by Frederick
County Court, sitting as a Court of Equity in case No. 3127, the said
Daniel Warrenfette as Trustee, has sold to Joseph Sinsbaugh, the fol-
lowing Property: Beginning at the end of 19 1/2 feet on the second
line of a tract of land called "Timber Land"; and running thence S. 44 1/2
N. 8 68/100 P. S. 4 1/2 N. 62 P. N. 82 N. 36 48/100 P. N. 9 E. 26 28/100 P. N. 54 1/2
N. 8 P. N. 40 N. 16 P. N. 26 1/2 E. 31 52/100 P. S. 81 E. 46 20/100 P. to the place
of beginning, containing and laid out for 18 acres 2 Rods and 2 poles.
Now therefore, the said Daniel Warrenfette, doth grant to the said Jos-
eph Sinsbaugh, all the right and title of the heirs in and to said
hereinbefore described Property.

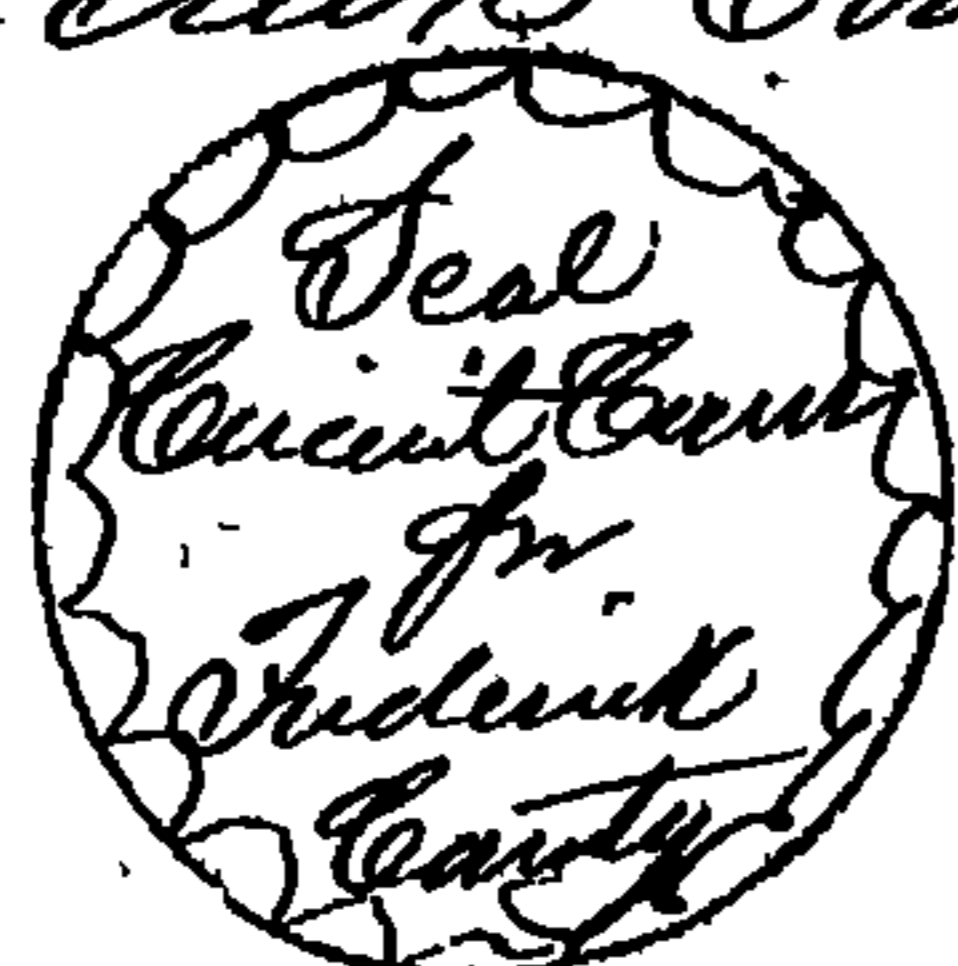

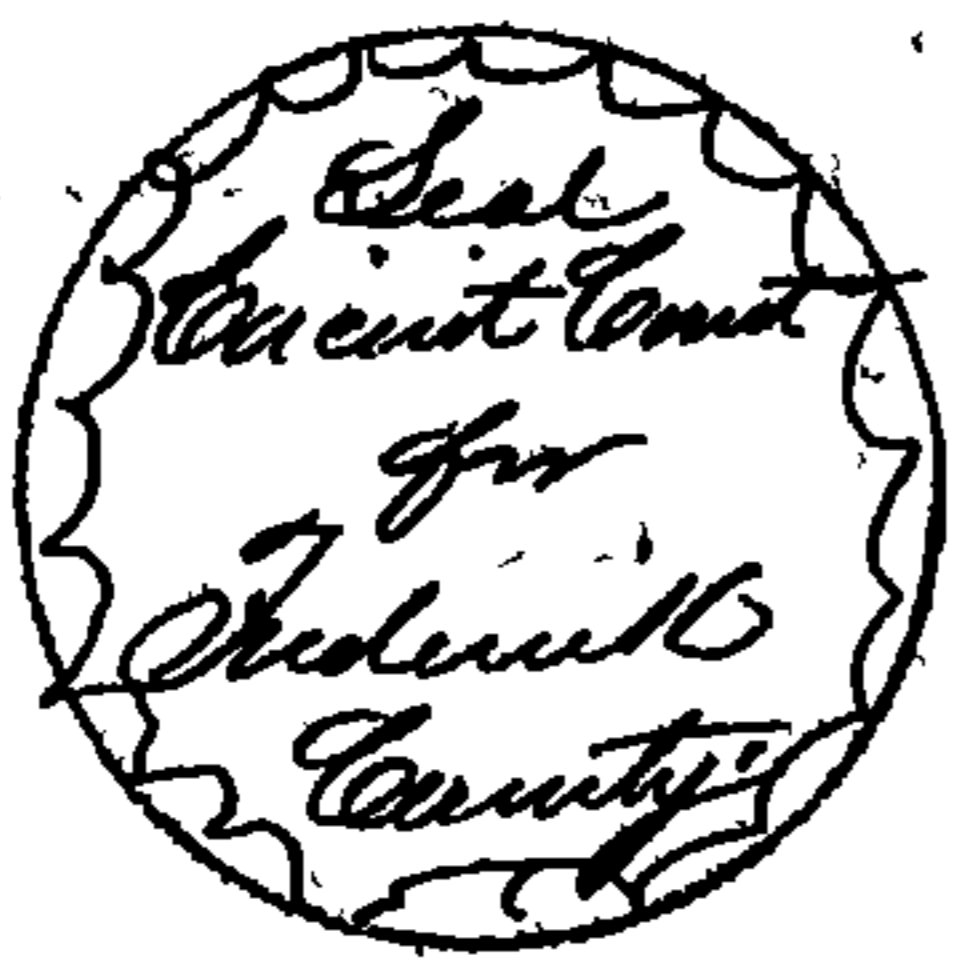
