2<sup>d</sup> Int: Were you acquainted with a certain Joseph Sensesbaugh formerly a resident of Frederick County, Maryland, if yes, is he dead or alive, if dead, when did he die, and did he die testate or intestate.

Ans: I was acquainted with Joseph Sensesbaugh. He is dead. He died in Frederick County, State of Maryland, at his home. He died intestate.

3<sup>d</sup> Int: Was or was not the said Joseph Sensesbaugh married. If no. Did he leave brothers and sisters and children of deceased brothers and sisters him surviving, if yes, state their names, ages and present places of residence, and if any are married, state the names of their husbands and wives?

Ans: Joseph Sensesbaugh was not married at the time of his death and never was married. He left one brother living. His name was Jacob Sensesbaugh. He is a very old man, of course over twenty one years of age and is married and the name of his wife is Catharine Sensesbaugh. They reside in the State of Indiana. Said Joseph Sensesbaugh had a brother John Sensesbaugh who died before the said Joseph leaving the following children surviving him. A son John W. Sensesbaugh the Complainant who is married and the name of whose wife is Amanda Sensesbaugh. They are over twenty one years of age and reside in Frederick County, State of Maryland. A son George A. Sensesbaugh married, and the name of whose wife is Catharine Sensesbaugh. They are over twenty one years of age and reside in the State of Indiana. A son Benjamin S.
