Thompson, and wife, to the said Thomas Marshall by deed bearing date August the Second in the year eighteen hundred and sixty nine, a certified copy of which deed as recorded among the Land Records of Frederick County is herewith filed as Exhibit No. 1. to this Complaint, which Exhibit with all other Exhibits by Complainants here filed, they pray may be considered as a part of this Bill of Complaint.
 These Complainants further represent, that the said Thomas Marshall deceased, left surviving him, his widow Rosanna Marshall who is still living and has a dower interest in said real estate, and the following heirs at law, Elizabeth Bowers who had intermarried with Jacob Bowers, Mary Bowers, who had intermarried with Coleman Bowers, Thomas Marshall, who had intermarried with Jane R. Marshall, they being his children and the above named Complainants, and also Sarah Elizabeth Marshall and James Thomas Marshall children of Levi Marshall, a deceased son of the said Thomas Marshall, all of which heirs at law are still living and residing in Frederick County, Maryland, excepting the two last mentioned children of Levi Marshall, who reside in Washington County, Maryland, to whom said real estate descended as tenants in common, and in whom its present title is now vested.
