

4th 3^o Int: I knew Thomas Marshall. He is dead. He died in Frederick County, in December A.D. 1876, or in January A.D. 1877. He died intestate. He left a widow, her name is Rosanna Marshall, she is now living. He left a daughter Elizabeth who is married and the name of whose husband is Jacob Bowers; a daughter Mary, who is married, and the name of whose husband is Coleman Bowers; a son Thomas Marshall who is married and the name of whose wife is Jane R. 4th Int: He had a son who died, before he said Thomas Marshall died, whose name was Levi Marshall, who left two children named Sarah E. Marshall and James J. Marshall, the Defendants, who are both infants under twenty one years of age & resides as above stated.

4th 5th Int: He died seized and possessed of real estate. He had a House and Lot situated in Leedstown, Frederick County, State of Maryland. It is worth about Two Hundred Dollars. I look at paper now shown me marked Exhibit No. 1. Said Exhibit describes the real estate of which said Thomas Marshall died seized and possessed.

4th 6th Int: It cannot be divided among said heirs at law. It would be best for the heirs, infants as well as adults to sell it and divide the proceeds, if any after debts are paid. It will be best to sell it because they can't agree among themselves who is to have it, and there is some hundreds of dollars of debts due, and unless sold it will go down in repair and value.
